

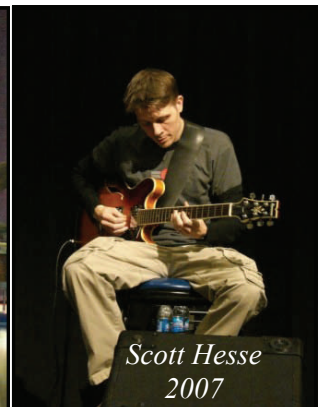

The Jazz Trio has performed together for 17 years at the Iowa Lakes Community College Jazz Festival and at the Iowa Lakes Community College University of Okoboji Reggie Schive Summer Jazz Camp.

The guest artists will be conducting workshops and rehearsals for Iowa Lakes' vocal and instrumental students and the traditional high school clinic on November 19. There will be an evening concert at the Lauridsen Theatre at the Lakes Art Center in Okoboji at 7:30 p.m. Admission is \$10 for adults and \$5 for children.
