8. Steve Rheinschmidt, our guest speaker over SKYPE in the session, shared this follow up with me.

Renee will share the ICCOC longitudinal demographic data for those of you interested. While we do not ask students if they are in high school in our pre-course survey, we do ask for their age. Our 17 and under demographic increased from 2% in the fall of 2004 to 14% in the fall of 2008. I would not be surprised if our 17 and under demographic is at or slightly above 15% this fall.

Fall 2004 enrollments totaled 5,199 making our 17 and under enrollment approximately 104 (duplicated head count).

Fall 2008 enrollments totaled 11,461 making our 17 and under enrollment approximately 1,605 (duplicated head count).
